- ON.12.02 Prohibit the use of indoor tanning equipment by youth**
Recommendation: Archive – now law as of October 9, 2013
- ON.10.01 Raising Awareness of Anaphylaxis**
Recommendation: Archive – Allergen labeling laws Feb. 2011, updated Aug. 2012. Awareness programs in schools, public places, etc. Notices posted in restaurants, etc. re common allergens
- ON.09.04 Reducing the Use of Disposable Products**
Recommendation: Archive - Much has been done by environmental groups in achieving objectives of this resolution. Public generally more conscious of the issue. Members should continue to encourage the use of non-disposable items wherever possible.
- ON.09.03 Mandatory Wearing of Properly Fitted Bicycle Helmets for All Ages**
Recommendation: Archive - Objective met - Highway Traffic Act Section 104 (1)
- ON.09.02 Make Dementia a Health Care Priority**
Recommendation: Archive - Current Res. ON.13.01 has more up to date reference materials. Mental Health includes dementia.
- ON.09.01 Automobile Tire Age - Safety Risk**
Recommendation: Archive – Inconsistencies in tire manufacture and quality leave too many variables to control. Discussions have been ongoing since 2011 with manufacturers to align Canadian safety standards with those of the US in order to improve safe performance of tires in Canada.
- ON.07.03 Withholding of Funds for Human Embryonic Stem Cell Research**
Recommendation: Archive – While issue is still relevant, information in brief, etc. needs to be updated and Resolution re-presented.
- ON.05.07 Reproductive Health and Women's Fertility Education**
Recommendation: Archive – Much has been done in this area, and more up-to-date information is available.
- ON.05.01 Comfort Allowance**
Recommendation: Archive – Ontario Regulation 79/10, Proposal 12-HLTC015 indicates an increase in comfort allowance to \$134. per month began Nov. 1, 2012.

- ON.04.01 Long Term Care**
Recommendation: Archive – Concerns addressed in Long Term Care Homes Act 2007, amended in 2010. The 2012 Physicians Services Agreement further addressed some of the issues.
- ON.00.03 Teen Suicide: Prevention**
Harold Albrecht MP for Kitchener Conestoga’s Bill C-300 will provide a federal framework for suicide prevention, requiring the federal government to provide guidelines to improve public awareness and knowledge of suicide, share best practices with agencies that deal with suicide prevention, and promote collaboration and knowledge exchange in suicide prevention. It was passed into law on December 14, 2012.
- ON.00.01 Use of Studded Tires in Ontario**
According to the Ministry of Transportation, studded tires may be used by northern residents living north of and including Parry Sound and Nipissing Districts from October 1 to April 1 inclusive.
- ON.99.05 Road Dust Suppressant: Dombind**
As of October 31, 2002, an Ontario Ministry of Environment order has put a permanent end to the use of Dombind as a road dust suppressant in Ontario.
- ON.97.02 Awareness of Another Risk Factor for Breast Cancer**
Recommendation: Archive – More current information is available and is widely publicized.
- ON.96.04 Women's Wellness - Education of Women Re: Heart Disease**
Recommendation: Archive – Factors re heart disease and stroke have been well publicized by various groups and educational materials are widely and readily available. National Resolution 1996.06 is virtually the same as this resolution.
- ON.94.04 Support for Palliative Care and the Hospice Movement**
Recommendation: Archive – Superseded by Resolution ON.09.06, which contains more recent references, etc. Many awareness programs continue to be carried out by the Canadian Hospice Palliative Care Association and others. Perhaps a new resolution with more current information needs to be prepared and presented.
- ON.88.08 Recycling of Waste**
Recommendation: Archive - Objectives achieved - Waste Diversion Act, 2002. National Resolution 1988.14 (same) has also been remanded, as objectives were achieved.
