On a wet and cool April night when the count took place, each group was given an area to walk where we were to search under bridges, in the bushes and wooded areas. The evening will be forever etched in your heart, hearing their stories and seeing where home is for them.

Sit back now and close your eyes as you hear the words of a homeless person.

Hi my name is Trish, my mom had been threatening to kick me out for a couple of years, the first time I was locked out I was 15. I would stay at my friend's house. My mom became unbearable. She was constantly yelling at me and smashing things. I thought she was going to kill me, so I went to my school counsellor and they said, 'they knew of a place I could get into'. My mom kicked me out once she found out I spoke to my school counsellor. 15 and all alone with only the clothes on my back.

Most youth who become homeless aren't well prepared to take care of themselves. As a youth, your housing should be provided for you so that can have friends, study, and do what you are supposed to do.

I like to be independent and not have anyone controlling my life. I'm really busy trying to be an adult. I'm aiming to get into college and I'm taking smart serve course so I can get into waitressing. Trish.

In closing remember when you drop of items, take time to talk with the homeless, or where ever you see them give a smile and a nod. Just don't walk by, show them they do matter.
