Proofing Tips

There are many tasks to keep track of in the process of producing good writing. Having a proofreading checklist on hand for that "last look" can help catch errors you otherwise miss. I have attached a reference list *Proofreading Tips*. It is always a challenge to find corrections within your own work. I have a few friends who love proofing and I call on them often to have a different pair of eyes on the writing and overall intent of the report. You may be called upon to proofread for someone or to guide someone who is proofing work. I have found these trips helpful.

Proofreading Tips

- Read your report/letter aloud. Sometimes writing sounds different in your head than it sounds on paper.
- Make a list of errors that you commonly make and keep an eye out for them.
- Read the text backwards. ...
- Proofread for only one type of error at a time.
- Double check everything: ...
- Read slowly and carefully.
