Domestic Violence Webinar (Saturday, February 11, 2023)

In Communiqué #14, Faith provided the following information on domestic violence. "In a Statistics Canada report entitled Spousal violence in Canada, 2019, previous research conducted by the Public Health Agency of Canada is summarized as follows. "Violence in the context of an intimate partner or spousal relationship can have immediate and long-term adverse physical and psychological consequences for victims, and children who are exposed to such violence have higher rates of violent victimization later in life. Further, in addition to individual impacts, there is a public cost of such violence for communities and society as a whole as health care, social support and legal systems must respond."
