Human Trafficking: I'm Worth It Now (IWIN)

Faith Anderson brought this initiative to our attention. IWIN is a registered charity co-founded by a Catholic Women's League parish council in Calgary and a police detective working with survivors of human trafficking. Their main goals are to assist trafficking survivors who have entered an exit program by providing backpacks with essential items, and raise awareness about the crime of human trafficking in Canada.

In her Communiqué #17, National Community Life Chairperson Faith Anderson mentions Pope Francis' historic visit to Canada in 2022 and the opportunity it has given the League to "... reflect on the role of its relationships with Indigenous women."

Faith advised that an *ad hoc* committee of national officers and Indigenous members has been formed to help deepen our relationships with Indigenous Catholic women.

"The committee wishes to gather information from members at large so it can recommend the necessary supports and resources to ensure Indigenous members are equally valued, respected, nurtured and able to fully participate in all League activities and projects, and to encourage them to take on leadership roles."
