Elections

For those preparing for elections at the upcoming diocesan conventions, here are a few hints to being prepared:

- 1. Review the election procedures in the National Manual of Policy and Procedure page 107 to 109.
- 2. Only parish presidents or a duly appointed proxy may vote during the diocesan election process based on an instructed vote. Be sure to inform your Presidents of this fact in advance along with the need for an instructed vote from parish presidents and encourage a proxy vote if they cannot attend themselves.
- 3. In advance of your diocesan convention, the President shall appoint a member, who is not a candidate for office, to be secretary of the elections. Ask the President to be prepared to appoint someone else should the original appointee not be available to attend the convention.
- 4. Prepare in advance of the convention, although it remains confidential until the convention, the complete list of offices with the candidates for each. When the complete list is displayed at the diocesan convention, the chairperson of elections (the chair of the nominations committee) should be prepared to introduce all the candidates.
- 5. Consider having the ability to play quiet, reflective music during the distribution and counting of ballots to keep the election respectful.
- 6. If you have positions with a single candidate, you must still have a motion to accept their appointment to the position by acclamation.
- 7. Provide a sample script for the President, and Chair of the Elections to use with options for a successful ballot, spoiled ballot or need for a further ballot. Having one script for each position would allow marking of the form for actual progress of election and the ability to start from a clean page each time.
