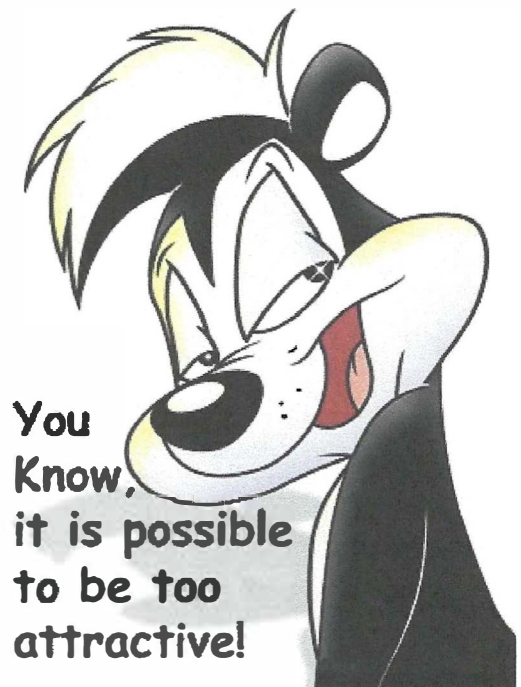

It was built in 1964 and symbolizes the wealth that Sudbury has contributed to the Canadian economy through nickel production. The base enables the public to walk around and under the 13,000-kg coin, with barrier-free access. The perfect place for a selfie!

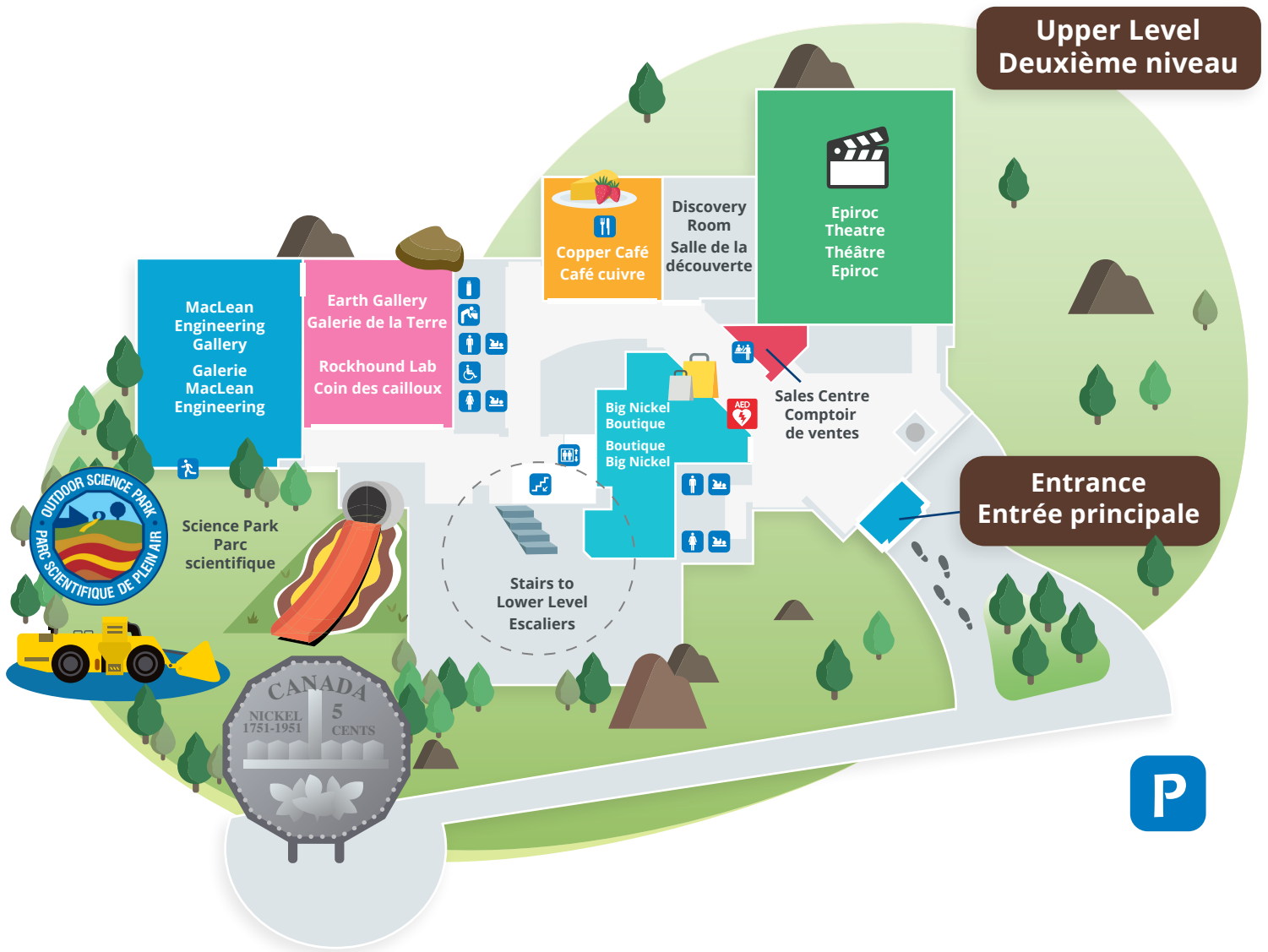

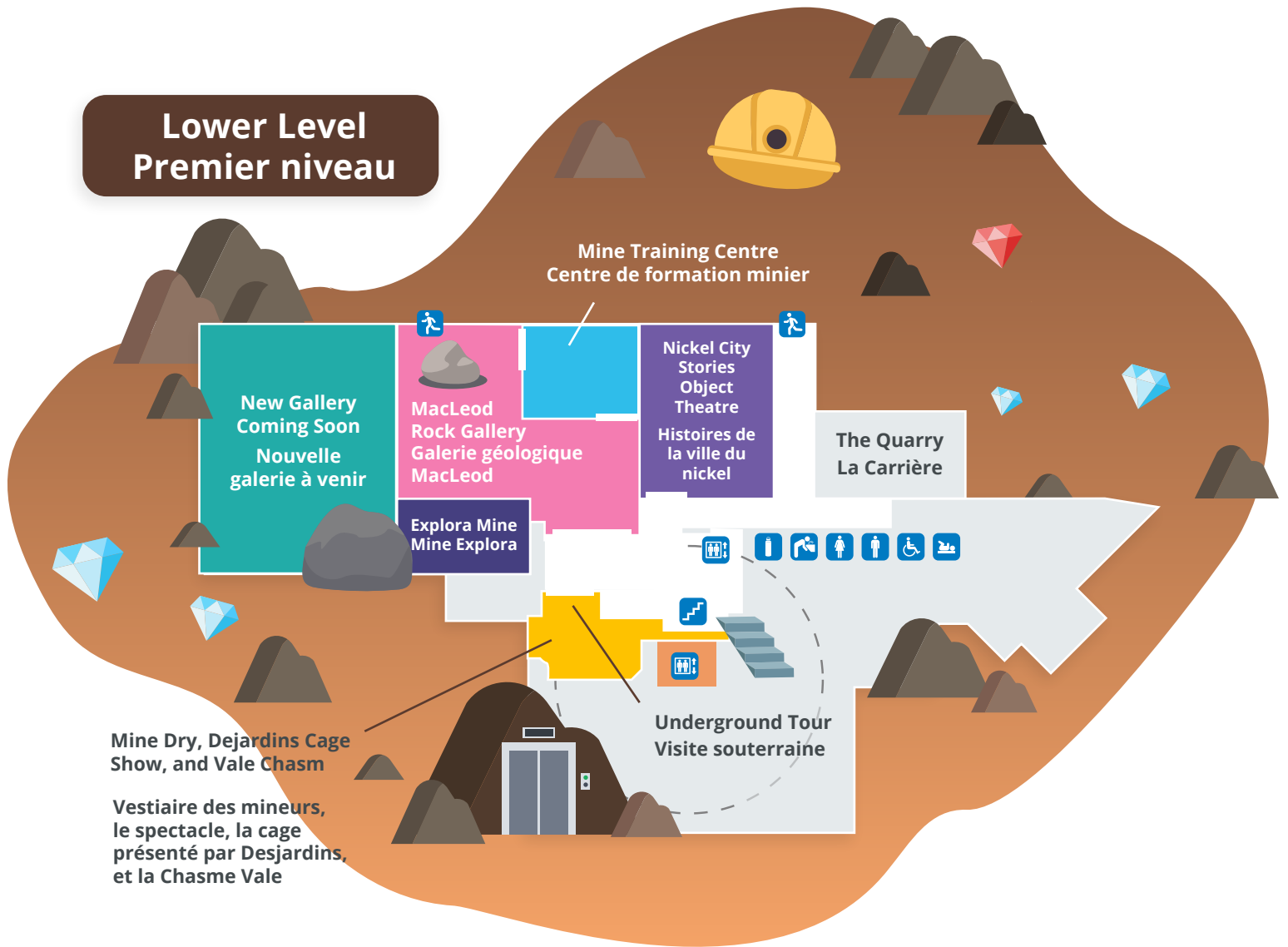
GROTTO OF OUR LADY OF LOURDES

3. Turn left onto Elgin Street (bottom the hill at the Bridge of Nations)
4. Turn right onto Shaughnessy Street. Sudbury Theatre Centre is on your right.
